

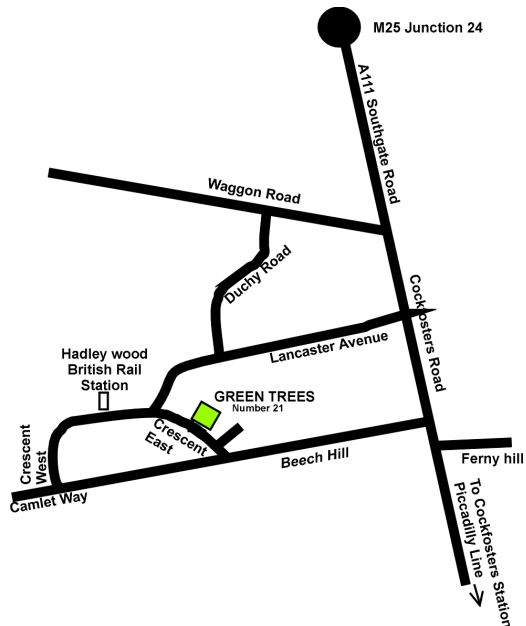
Transport.

The home is a 5 minute walk from Hadley Wood station, which is on the Welwyn Garden City to Moorgate / Kings Cross Line.

The nearest regular bus service is on Cockfosters Road, about 10 minutes walk, timetables are available at the home.

The nearest underground station is Cockfosters which is on the Piccadilly line and around 40 minutes walk.
